YOUR OWN AMBITIONS

A few months after Henriette's death, Louis seems to have completed the grieving process and overcome his pain, but he will need time to get back on his feet.

In this season, Louis XIV has finalised the first stage of his ambitious plan. But, just like King Midas, who learned the same lesson at his own expense, he will discover that realising your dreams can also turn out to be dangerous. Absolute power does not come without immense responsibilities...especially for such a young man. Sometimes, power is a heavy burden to bear. Becoming the captain is one thing, steering the ship is guite another.

Inside the golden prison that Versailles has become, business is going well. With new faces in court, new alliances are being forged, new threats emerge...And the ladies are breathing fresh air into Versailles.

Madame de Montespan is the King's new favourite. Climbing steadily up the ladder, she now holds a prominent place in the court. The singular and fiery princess Palatine, future wife of Philippe; the virtuous but temperamental Madame Scarron; and the Queen Marie-Thérèse, ready to counter-attack by rallying her supporters to her cause.

In the Queen's eyes (and those of others, like Bishop Bossuet), the court is in rapid decline, and the situation is only getting worse. The immoral gangrene spreads a little further every day. Fabien Marchal sees the imminent threat to the king and the palace; for if Versailles buckles under this burden, all of France will be swept up in its fall.

Fabien is fighting on all fronts, and his task is far from easy. Courtiers flock to Versailles; this is when the poison scandal erupts. Poisonings become a form of currency in court: a solution that inspires more and more people to rid themselves of potential rivals. But is this just a manifestation of the decay weakening Versailles, or is it an indicator of a more complex conspiracy concocted beyond the palace walls?

Condemned by the king, Philippe and the Chevalier de Lorraine (back from exile) are glad to be away from the court. But they soon get drawn back into its intrigues. They will not be left out, and so set themselves a goal: if Louis wants to shine like the Sun, then Philippe will sparkle like the Moon. He will be the star in the darkness.

Will a monarch's dream see him caught in a trap of his own making?

THE DARK SIDE OF VERSAILLES

~

The success of the first season of VERSAILLES reinforced the choices we made. We have produced the second season by drawing on what made the first season impactful and original, whilst seeking to plough the furrow of historical fiction in an even more surprising way...lt was with this in mind that the actors and teams threw themselves into pushing the artistic demands that create Versailles' identity even further.

It will be clear that our project is situated far, far away from "Once upon a time in Versailles" and from the hagiographic portrait of Louis XIV as an absolute monarch painted by the history books. This modern approach makes Louis a fictitious character and makes his internal struggle accessible; a struggle between private fears and lofty ambitions.

In this new season, we want to dare to show the dark side of Versailles, in a world where history often prefers to remember only the light. Before becoming the absolute monarch that we know, Louis will have to overcome the most terrible of obstacles, both political and private.

Women play a central role in season two. Sometimes sublime and ambitious, sometimes vulnerable and loving, sometimes iconoclastic and spiritual, but always determined and unique. They punctuate the narrative and make it original. It was vital to place them at the heart of the tale because they really were the beating heart of Versailles, and their influence on the fingerprint left by the reign of Louis XIV was fundamental.



1672-1678. The Franco-Dutch war wages on, Louis XIV confronts his bitter rival, Guillaume d'Orange. But danger threatens even inside the kingdom, within the court of Versailles itself with the Poison scandal. Between mysticism and obscurity, a dive into the dark side of power, with the king's downward spiral, and his return towards the light.

Louis has completed the first stage of his plan: to build the most beautiful palace in Europe, far away from Paris...And to lock the nobility inside it so as to exercise absolute control over it. But his plan backfires. Louis has created a new civilisation where the courtiers are ready to do anything to get to the Sun. Behind the veneer of etiquette, they dream of money, power, and climbing the social ladder. They will do whatever they have to: morality is waning, and poison spreads...Versailles is rotting. Blinded by his affection for Madame de Montespan, Louis is deaf to the Church's injunctions. The greatest enemy standing before him is no longer the nobility, nor is it Guillaume d'Orange: the palace that he himself designed could end up becoming his worst enemy.





AN INTERNATIONAL EVENT

The series has already been sold to over 135 countries, including major territories such as the United States, England, Germany, Spain, the Scandinavian countries, Belgium, Russia, Poland, Australia, Brazil and all the Latin American countries.

VERSAILLES has gathered viewing figures from its showings, such as on BBC Two in the United Kingdom, which achieved the channel's highest viewing figures since 2010 for a purchased series, with three million TV viewers and an audience share twice the usual average for that segment.

In the United States, the series became the best ever series launched on Ovation, and also features in the top 10 most downloaded programmes since the channel's inception. It was also a huge success in Germany, on Sky Deutschland, with a 62% increase on average figures for the segment, and in French-speaking Belgium (third highest viewing figures for fiction in two years on La Deux), in Flemish Belgium (highest viewing figures of the year for a costume drama on Eén), and in Spain (best audience for that period on Movistar+ across all genres and segments).



THE DUKE OF CASSEL

PIP TORRENS

To everyone's surprise, Louis decides to appoint the duke of Cassel as Minister of Justice, a post that has remained vacant after the fatal poisoning of his predecessor. Louis is aware of the danger posed by Cassel, and hopes to control him better by keeping him close-by, even if it means giving him power, and cruelly forcing Sophie to marry him, despite knowing that she is Fabien's spy. This way, he hopes to keep Cassel under constant surveillance. But Cassel does not change. He continues to be a deceitful, sadistic man...with an unabashed appetite for young women. He will make Sophie his victim. But the predator could become the prey...

CLAUDINE

LIZZIE BROCHERÉ

It is not just supporters that the king's doctor holds in the court. As Claudine monitors Madame de Montespan's pregnancy, the "Queen of Versailles" takes a dislike to her, unable to bear another woman having such direct and personal access to Louis. So she begins a campaign to push her out of Versailles. But Claudine is not a woman who is easily defeated. From the village, she and Fabien continue their investigations into the mystery of the poisons used in the court, and try to find the supplier. But by seeking too many answers, she ends up making increasingly dangerous enemies.

GRETA SCACCHI

An old friend of Madame de Montespan's family, she arrives at court in the hope of finding a position for her son Gaston. But beneath her elegant exterior, Madeleine is determined and dangerous. Utterly devoted to her son, she is prepared to do anything to help him climb the social ladder.



JAMES JOINT

Renowned for his devotion, he arrives at court as personal confessor to the Queen. Marie-Thérèse hopes that he will help her to steer the court of Versailles back to the path of morality and piety, and to convince Louis to end his adulterous relations with Madame de Montespan. But making an enemy of Montespan turns out to be very dangerous...and he would be wrong to underestimate her power.

NED DENNEHY

At first glance, Father Etienne seems the epitome of the benevolent, devoted priest, passing his time in the brothels, taverns and ill-famed districts to take care of those most in-need. He takes particular care of the children of prostitutes, by placing them in orphanages. But Father Etienne is hiding a very dark underbelly.

GEORGE WEBSTER

The young Dutchman, contending for power, remains Louis' main rival in Europe. Having failed in his attempt to kidnap the Dauphin, h is determined to find other ways to destabilise Louis and thwart his plans for expansion. The counterpart of Louis, Guillaume too dreams of glory and power. But to do this, he must topple De Witt, the man who raised him like a son, but who, he believes, usurped the throne. He has placed trusted contacts very close to the king, including the spy Thomas Beaumont, who has managed to win the role of the LOUIS XIV
